## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #602 (1980)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #424 (1977), as amended, to provide for payment of the Council Stipends.

WHEREAS Section 389 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended, provides that Council of the municipality may pass by-laws for paying the members of Council such annual allowances Council may determine;

AND WHEREAS Section 211 of the said Municipal Act provides that the head of Council may be paid such annual or other remunerations the Council may determine;

AND WHEREAS Section 392 of the said Municipal Act provides that 1/3 of such amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties as a member of Council;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1)THAT the Mayor of the Council be paid the sum of \$6,300.00 per annum and 1/3 of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties.
- (2) THAT the Aldermen of Council be paid an annual allowance of \$3,600.00 and 1/3 of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties.
- (3) THAT the remuneration provided by this by-law shall be paid as follows:
- (i) Aldermen of Council shall be paid quarterly in the months of February, May, August and November.
- (ii) Mayor of Council shall be paid bi-weekly at the same time as full time staff members of the municipality are paid.
- THAT the rate of remuneration for the Mayor and Aldermen, as (4) set out above, shall be effective as of January 1st., 1980.
- (5) THAT By-law #424 (1977) and By-law #498 (1978) of the Town of Pelham be and the same are hereby repealed and the foregoing shall henceforth be in force and effect.
