BY-LAW #616 (1980)

Being a by-law to authorize the sale of
land.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS THAT:

- (1) By-law #528 (1979) is hereby rescinded;
- (2) The land hereinafter particularly described, namely,
ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of
land and premises, situate, lying and being in
the Town of Pelham, in the Regional Municipality
of Niagara, formerly in the Village of Fonthill,
in the County of Welland, and being composed of
Part of the south part of Block "U" of Registered
Plan No. 25 for the said Village of Fonthill now
known as Plan No. 717 more particularly described
as follows:

COMMENCING at the southwest angle of said Block
"U";

THENCE North along the western limits of said
Block, 348.3 feet to a stake;

THENCE East parallel with the southern boundary
of said Block "U", 1,258 feet to the eastern
limits thereof;

THENCE South 348.33 feet to the southern boundary
of said Block "U";

THENCE West along the said southern boundary of
said Block "U", 1,258 feet to the place of
beginning.

BE SOLD TO MRS. SUSAN BENI
FOR THE SUM OF \$2,617.44

AND THAT THE MAYOR AND CLERK are hereby authorized to execute
such documents as may be necessary thereof, and to attach the Corporate Seal
thereto.
