

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #623 (1980)

Being a by-law to provide for the appointment
of additional members to the Pelham Hydro-
Electric Commission.

WHEREAS the Niagara Municipal Hydro-Electric Service Act, 1979
provides that each hydro electric commission shall consist of the Mayor of
the area municipality in respect of which the Commission is established and
either two or four additional members who are qualified electors under The
Municipal Elections Act, 1977, in the area municipality;

AND WHEREAS for the term commencing after the 30th. day of
November, 1980, the additional members shall be elected by a general vote
of the electors of the area municipality unless the Council provides by
by-law that the additional members shall be appointed by Council;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of
Pelham deems it desirable to appoint the additional members to the Pelham
Hydro-Electric Commission;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the four additional members of the Pelham Hydro-Electric
Commission be appointed by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of
Pelham for terms commencing after the 30th. day of November, 1980.
