

THE CORPORATION OF THE

BY-LAW #634 (1980)

Being a by-law to repeal By-law #478 (1978)
Being a by-law to offer to purchase land in
the core area from the Church and provide
for temporary financing.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham
passed By-law #478 (1978) to provide for the purchase of 4.2 acres from
the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation for the Diocese of St. Catharines
in Canada for the purpose of a senior citizens apartment, library or either
of them and the balance for park purposes;

AND WHEREAS part of the purchase price was to be raised by
temporary financing beyond the term of Council and thereby requiring Ontario
Municipal Board approval;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham
no longer deems it desirable to proceed with the development as proposed in
By-law #478 (1978) but wishes to proceed with the development as outlined
in By-law #614 (1980);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT By-law #478 (1978) be and is hereby repealed.
