

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #653 (1980)

Being a by-law to assume a street lighting plant
in the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 354 (1) of The Municipal Act provides that Councils
of local municipalities may pass by-laws for the acquiring of street lighting
systems;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to assume the cost of future
street light purchases and assume the unpaid street light capital in the area
served by the Pelham Hydro-Electric Commission;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the unpaid street light capital of the Corporation of the
Town of Pelham amounting to \$4,900.00 be assumed for financing by the Council
of the Town of Pelham.
- (2) THAT this sum be assumed during the period of one (1) year from
the 1st. day of January, 1980 and that the sum be paid to the Pelham Hydro-
Electric Commission.
- (3) THAT the Corporation of the Town of Pelham will assume all capital
cost incurred for new lighting and lighting improvements from the date of the
passing of this by-law.
- (4) NOTHING in this by-law shall divest the Pelham Hydro-Electric
Commission from the privileges and powers conferred by Section 41 of The
Public Utilities Act, R.S.O.
