BY-LAW NUMBER ___65 (1970)

THE CORPORATION OF THE

TOWN OF PELHAM

Being a By-law to provide for the Nomination of Candidates for the Niagara South Board of Education, according to the Secondary Schools and Boards of Education Act, 1968 and amendments thereto

WHEREAS the Secondary Schools and Boards of Education Amendment Act, 1968 provides for the election of members to a Divisional Board of Education

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Nominations of Candidates for the Town of Pelham for the Niagara South Board of Education, a divisional board, as prescribed by the above recited act, will be held on the 23rd. day of November at the hours of 7 to 8 o'clock in the evening, Eastern Standard Time, in the A. K. Wigg School, Haist Road South.
- 2. THAT one member will be elected to the said divisional Board to represent the Town of Pelham.
- 3. (a) THAT, if more candidates are nominated than is required to fill the vacancy, Polling for the election will take place in the municipality on the 7th. day of December, 1970 at such polling places as shall be established, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. according to the above noted act.
- (b) THAT if more candidates are nominated than required to fill the vacancy for the separate school member on the Niagara South Board of Education, the nomination meeting which will be held by the Clerk of the Town of Thorold for the combined areas of the municipalities of Pelham, Thorold and Wainfleet, Polling for the election will be the same day set out in paragraph 3(a) of this by-law.
- (c) THAT if more candidates are nominated than required to fill the vacancy for the Welland County Roman Catholic Separate School Board, the nomination for which will be held by the Clerk of the Township of Wainfleet for the combined areas of the municipalities of Pelham and Wainfleet, Polling for the election will be the same day as set out in paragraph 3(a) of this by-law.

4. THAT Mr. L. C. Hunt, Clerk of the Municipality of Pelham shall be returning officer for the said elections and shall do all things prescribed by the above recited Act and the Municipal Act.
