Being a by-law to dedicate certain lands as
a public park in the Pelham Town Square.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham
is the owner of certain lands located in the Pelham Town Square;


AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and desirable to dedicate
a portion of these lands as public park;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the area as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and
forming part of this by-law, be and is hereby dedicated as public park.

- (2) THAT the general management, regulation and control of the
park property shall be exercised by the Town of Pelham, Parks, Recreation
& Community Centres Committee, who shall make such recommendations to
Council, as it deems necessary, for the development and maintenance of
the park area.
