

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #676 (1981)

Being a by-law to issue and charge fees for
licenses to hunt during the open season,
pheasants and rabbits.

WHEREAS Section 39 of The Game & Fish Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 186, as amended, provides that the Minister of Natural Resources may, in writing, authorize any Municipality to pass by-laws for issuing and fixing the maximum number of licenses to hunt during the open season, pheasants and rabbits and for charging such fees therefore as he authorizes; the Minister may also fix the minimum number of such licenses that the by-law shall provide for;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT no person shall hunt pheasants and rabbits within the Town of Pelham, in the Region of Niagara, until a license for that purpose has been obtained, and such licenses to be in addition to any other licenses required by The Game & Fish Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 186, as amended.
- (2) THE Clerk of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Pelham, or other person or persons appointed from time to time by the Council, shall issue and sell the following:
 - (a) a license for non-residents of the Town of Pelham, to hunt pheasants and rabbits at a fee of \$4.00 plus 50¢ issuing fee
 - (b) a license for residents of the Town of Pelham, to hunt pheasants and rabbits at a fee of \$2.80 plus 50¢ issuing fee
- (3) THE fee prescribed shall be paid for each license when same is issued.
- (4) THE license issuer shall receive 50¢ for each non-resident license issued and 50¢ for each resident license issued.
- (5) IN this by-law, the words "RESIDENT OF THE TOWN" means any person who is a resident of the Town of Pelham.
- (6) IN this by-law, the words "NON-RESIDENT OF THE TOWN" means any person who does not reside within the Town of Pelham.
- (7) A minimum of 200 licenses must be made available for use of non-residents, and no restrictions on the number available to residents of the Town of Pelham.

(8) THAT all previous by-laws passed by the Town of Pelham, which are inconsistent herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed,

IT IS ALSO PROVIDED, that this By-law does not apply to any land of the Crown, and any land commonly known as wildlife extension land owners agreement area situated within the areas referred to in this By-law,

THIS BY-LAW, shall come into force and effect on the date of the final passing thereof, subject to the Minister of Natural Resources authorizing in writing, the passing of the by-law.
