

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW # 677 (1981)

Being a by-law to amend By law #825 (1967) of the former Village of Fonthill, a by-law for the regulation of traffic and By-law #607 (1980) and By-law #666 (1980) by-laws to regulate parking in certain areas of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and advisable to amend by-laws;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the text of Part V - Penalties of By-law #825 (1967) of the former Village of Fonthill be and is hereby repealed and the following added in its place:

"Every person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$25.00. The owner of a vehicle that is parking in contravention of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$25.00, unless the owner proves to the satisfaction of the court that at the time of the offence, the motor vehicle was in the possession of another person without the owner's consent, express or implied."

(2) THAT the General Penalties section of By-law #607 (1980) and By-law #666 (1980) be amended by deleting the following:

"Any person violating any of the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to a penalty of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$25.00 exclusive of costs, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under The Ontario Summary Convictions Act,"

and adding the following in its place:

"Every person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$25.00. The owner of a vehicle that is parked in contravention of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$25.00, unless the owner proves to the satisfaction of the court that at the time of the offence the motor vehicle was in the possession of another person without the owner's consent, express or implied."
