

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
T O W N    O F    P E L H A M  
BY-LAW NUMBER 67 (1970)

Being a By-law to establish polling places for each polling subdivision and to appoint election officers for the election of the Niagara South Board of Education and the Welland County Roman Catholic Separate School Board.

WHEREAS Council is empowered to pass by-laws for establishing one or more polling places in each polling subdivision and

WHEREAS Council may pass by-laws for providing a polling place for a polling subdivision in an adjoining polling subdivision and

WHEREAS Council is empowered to appoint election officials for the election.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Polling Stations for each polling Subdivision shall be as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
2. The fee for polling stations shall be as follows:
  1. Single Poll - \$25.00
  2. Additional Polls in same location \$10.00 per poll.
3. The election officers for the election shall be as set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
4. The fees for the election officers shall be as follows:

1. Returning Officer	\$150.00
2. Election Assistant	50.00
3. D.R.O.	24.00
plus mileage at the rate of 12¢ per mile for returning the ballot box.	
4. Poll Clerks	18.00
5. Constables	10.00
	per poll.
5. All previous by-laws are repealed and amended only to the extent necessary to give effect to the provisions of this by-law.
6. This by-law shall take effect on the date of passing.
