THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN 0 F PELHAM

BYALAW #694 (1981)

Being a by-law to name the roadways in the Municipal Core Area.

WHEREAS Paragraph 97 of Subsection 1 of Section 354 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended, provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities for the naming of highways;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 9 of Section 363 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended, provides for the numbering of the buildings and lots along highways;

AND WHEREAS the readway leading to the Municipal Building and parking was established as a municipal road allowance and named "Pelham Town Square";

AND WHEREAS the roadway has been extended on the north and south sides of the Municipal Core area and dedicated as public highway;

AND WHEREAS Council in studying the development of the downtown core feels it is desirable to refer to the entire street layout as "Pelham Town Square";

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT those portions of road allowance shown on Reference Plan (1)#59R-3237 and designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 and those portions of road allowance shown on Reference Plan #59R-3066 as Parts 1 and 3 be named "Pelham Town Square."
- THAT the buildings and lots along Pelham Town Square be (2) numbered as shown on the plan attached hereto and marked as Schedule "A" to this by-Daw.
