## THE CORPORATION OF THE

TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NUMBER 69 (1970)

Being a By-law to unite polling subdivision in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Town of Pelham has been combined with the Town of Thorold and Township of Wainfleet for the purpose of electing one Separate School member on the Niagara South Board of Education, and

WHEREAS there are only approximately 427 eligible Separate School electors in the Town of Pelham, and

WHEREAS Section 59 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. provides that by-laws may be passed for uniting for any purpose any two adjourning subdivisions and establishing one polling place therefor.

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PEL-HAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The following Polling Subdivisions shall be united for this election only and the polling station shall be held as set out in Schedule "A" of By-law #67:

## WARD 1

Polls l-3, l-4 and l-5 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the Fenwick Fire Hall.

## WARD 2

Polls 2-1 and 2-2 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the former Pelham Township Hall.

Polls 2-3 and 2-4 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the Davis Hall Community Centre.

Polls 2-5 and the united poll of 2-6 & 2-7 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the Holy Trinity Church Hall.

## WARD 3

Polls 3-1, 3-4 and 3-5 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the A. K. Wigg School.

Polls 3-2 and 3-3 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the Fonthill Baptist Church Hall.

Polls 3-6 and 3-8 shall be united and there shall be one polling station to be held in the Fonthill Senior Public School.

- 2. By-law #67 of the Town of Pelham is amended only to the extent to give effect to this by-law.
- 3. This by-law shall take effect on the final date of passing thereof.
