

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #713 (1981)

Being a by-law to establish a 50 k.p.h. speed
limit on Effingham Street.

WHEREAS Subsection 2 of Section 82 of the Highway Traffic Act,
R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 202 provides that the Council of a municipality and
the trustees of a police village may by by-law prescribe a higher or
lower rate of speed for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion
of a highway under its jurisdiction than is prescribed in Subsection 1
of Section 82;

AND WHEREAS the statutory speed limit on Effingham Street is
80 k.p.h. under the Highway Traffic Act, and the Regional Municipality of
Niagara Act.


AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed limit for
motor vehicles on certain highways in the municipality of Pelham be either
decreased or increased or both;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT when any highway or portion of highway, set out in Schedule
"A" attached hereto, is marked in compliance with the regulations under
The Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be the
rate of speed prescribed in the schedule.
- (2) THAT the penalties provided in Subsection 13 of Section 82 of
The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall not become effective until approved by
the Council of the Regional Municipality of Niagara and signs are erected.
- (4) THAT By-Law #707 (1981) be and is hereby repealed.
