## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM By-Law #714 (1981)

Being a by-law to establish a reserve fund to supplement a long-term disability plan for municipal employees

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, provides that municipalities may in each year, provide in the estimates for the establishment or maintenance of a reserve fund for any purpose for which it has authority to spend funds.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and desirable to establish a reserve fund to supplement the benefits of certain municipal employees who are not covered to the same degree or the municipal employees who have qualified for complete coverage under the long-term disability plan currently in force in the Town of Pelham.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:

- THAT Mr. Gordon White, Mr. Lloyd Tunnacliffe, Mr. Wilfred Minor, and Mr. Gordon Cherney shall be provided with supplementary coverage by the Town of Pelham with respect to long-term disability benefits if an when they qualify for benefits under the terms of the Commercial Union long-term disability benefit plan or such other longterm disability plans as may be implemented from time to time.
- 2. THAT the above-named persons shall be entitled to receive, from the Town of Pelham, an amount equal to that which would have been paid to these employees if they had qualified for full coverage under the long-term disability plan less any monies received by the employee from the insurer and any other federal, provincial and municipal disability benefits payable to the employee.
- THAT a Reserve Fund be established to accumulate funds to offset any benefits which may become payable, and that such Reserve Fund shall be known as the Reserve Fund for long-term disability benefits.
- 4. THAT a sum of \$3,500 be deposited in the Reserve Fund on or before December 31st., 1981, and that future deposits be made at Council's discretion in future years.
