## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN O F PELHAM BY-LAW NO. 717(1981)

Being a by-law to close and stop up the original road allowances between Lots 2 and 3, Concession 2; and part of the original road allowance between Lots 2 and 3, Concession 3; and part of the original road allowance between Concessions 1 and 2; and part of the original road allowance between the former Townships of Pelham and Thorold.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Pelham, hereinafter called the Corporation, that the original unopened road allowances set out and described in Schedule "A" attached hereto be closed and stopped up; and the land sold to the adjoining landowners;

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-Law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the Pelham Herald, a newspaper published weekly in the Town of Pelham;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudically affected by this By-Law and who applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Pelham enacts as follows:

- (1) That upon and after the passing of thie By-Law all those portions of the 66 foot allowances for the road set out and described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, be and the same are hereby closed and stopped up.
- (2) All those parts of the said unopened road allowances herein before described and stopped up shall be sold to the adjoining owner or owners or any of them.
- (3)The Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham are hereby authorized to sign or execute such deeds or other documents as may be necessary to effect conveyance of those parts of the said unopened road allowances herein before described and which have been stopped up and closed.
