THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW NO. 718(1981)

Being a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 450(1978) which amends Zoning By-Law No. 279(1974) of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary in the public interest to pass a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 450(1978).

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 39 of The Planning Act, as amended, by-laws may be passed by Councils of Municipalities for prohibiting or regulating the use of land and the erection of buildings or structures within the Municipality for or except for such purposes as may be set out in the by-law, and for regulating in certain respects buildings or structures to be erected within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 3 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by deleting the following definitions:
 - " 3.51.1 Intensive Animal Operation
 - 3.58.1 Lot, farm-related
 - 3.66.1 Lot, non-farm related"
- 2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by adding the following definition:

- 3. Sections 4, 11 and 12 of By-Law No. 450(1978) are hereby amended by deleting the reference to "Residential Village 2" and "RV2".
- 4. Section 9 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by changing subsection 8.1 contained therein, which are the permitted uses of the "Agricultural Al Zone" to read as follows:

8.1 Permitted Uses

- (a) Agricultural operations which shall include:
 - (i) a dairy or beef operation but not including the raising or keeping of more than ½ animal unit/acre/year of any other type of livestock,
 - (ii) one one family detached dwelling, and greenhouses.
- (b) Seasonal or permanent farm help houses on farms larger than 10 hectares.

Explanatory Note

Applications to permit farm help houses on farms less than 10 hectares will be considered by Council. This note is for information only and does not form a part of the By-Law.

- (c) one one family detached dwelling (new or existing) on one lot.
- (d) uses, buildings and structures accessory to the uses permitted in clauses (a) (ii) and (c) of this subsection.
- (e) household occupations subject to the provisions of subsection 10.2.
- 5. Section 9 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by deleting clause (c) of subsection 8.4 contained therein.
- 6. Section 9 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by deleting subsection 8.5 contained therein.
- 7. Section 9 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by changing the heading of subsection 8.6 contained therein to read as follows:

 "8.6 Regulations for Accessory Buildings Permitted in Clause (d) of Subsection 8.1"
- 8. Section 9 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by the addition of the following to clause (a) of subsection 8.7 contained therein.

 "The minimum acceptable separation distance determined from M.D.S. Formula 1 shall be 300 metres."
- 9. Section 10 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by changing clauses (a) and (b) of subsection 9.1 contained therein, which are the permitted uses of the "Agricultural A2 Zone" to read as follows:

- "(a) agricultural operations, including the keeping or raising of any livestock, greenhouses, and one one family detached dwelling.
 - all uses permitted in clauses (b), (c), (d) and (e) of subsection 8.1 hereof."
- Section 10 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by 10. deleting subsections 9.2, 9.3 and 9.4 contained therein and adding a new subsection 9.2 which shall read as follows:
 - "9.2 Regulations for Uses Permitted in Subsection 9.1 The regulations which apply to the uses permitted in subsection 8.1 shall apply mutatis mutandis to the uses permitted in subsection 9.1 hereof."
- 11. Section 13 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by changing clauses (a) and (b) of subsection 14A.2 contained therein, which is the "Residential Village RV1 Zone", to read as follows:

- 12. Section 14 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby deleted.
- 13. Section 24 of By-Law No. 450(1978) is hereby amended by the addition of the following exceptions:
 - "#129 This land may only be used for an airport and uses, buildings and structures accessory thereto."
 - In addition to the uses permitted in the "Agricultural Al Zone", the land indicated by number 130 on Schedule "B" may also be used for the production and sale of canoes and uses, buildings and structures accessory thereto."
- Schedule "B", which consists of Maps 1, 2, 3 and 4 thereto, are hereby deleted and replaced by Schedule "B" attached hereto and by this reference forming a part of this By-Law.
- 15. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect the day of its passing, subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
