BY-LAW NUMBER 71 (1970)

Being a By-law to declare the desirability of undertaking certain works as a local improvement under the provisions of Section 8, Paragraph 1 of The Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has determined that it is desirable that the work hereinafter described should be undertaken as a local improvement without petition;

THEREFORE The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof enacts as follows:

1. That it is hereby declared that it is desirable that a 6-inch diameter watermain extension be constructed on the following named street between the points hereinafter mentioned, namely:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
North Pelham Street	A point approximately 1,030 feet north of Hurricane Road	A point approximately 1,423 feet north of Hurricane Road

2. That notice of this Council's intention to undertake the said work in the form annexed to this by-law be published as required by the said Act.

PASSED at a meeting of the Council duly called and held on the 30th. day of November, 1970, by a vote of two-thirds of all the members of Council.
