

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
T O W N   O F   P E L H A M  
BY-LAW NO. 729(1981)

Being a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 727(1981),  
a by-law to establish certain water rates  
upon real property within Pelham Water Works  
Area No. 3.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary  
and desirable to make certain additions to By-Law No. 727(1981),

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS  
FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT By-Law No. 727(1981) be amended by the addition of the  
following:

- (a) "And Whereas Section 219(1) of the Municipal Act  
R.S.O. 1980 authorizes Councils of local municipalities  
to require owners of buildings in a defined area to  
connect the said buildings to the water works" after  
paragraph 8 of Page 1 of By-Law No. 727(1981).
- (b) "(6) That owners of all existing buildings within  
the water works area connect those buildings which  
contain water and/or sewage facilities to the  
water works within two (2) years of the completion  
of the water works and that all new buildings or  
renovated buildings which are equipped with water  
and/or sewage facilities be required to connect  
to the water works immediately upon completion  
of construction or renovation of the building",  
after Section 5 of By-Law No. 727(1981).
- (c) "in the amount of \$40,700" after the word "debentures"  
in Section 10 (New Section 11) of By-Law No. 727(1981).

2. THAT By-Law No. 727(1981) be amended by changing the Section  
Numbers of By-Law No. 727(1981) as follows:

- "Section (6)" to "Section (7)"; "Section (7)" to "Section (8)";
- "Section (8)" to "Section (9)"; "Section (9)" to "Section(10)";
- "Section (10)" to "Section(11)" & "Section(11)" to "Section(12)";

3. THAT this By-Law shall not come into force or take effect  
until it has been approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.
