BY-LAW #739 (1981)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #233 (1974)
being a by-law to licence and regulate and
govern plumbing contractors, master
plumbers and journeyman plumbers

WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham
deems it necessary to amend Section 21, fees for permits and inspections:

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That Section 21 of By-law #233 (1974), fees for permits and inspections, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
- (2) (21) The Fees for permits and inspections under this by-law shall be as follows:
 - (1) For a single family dwelling house, \$5.00 plus \$2.00 for each fixture to be installed therein and \$2.00 for each additional stack in excess of one.
 - (2) For an apartment house, duplex, triplex or multiple family dwelling: \$5.00 for the first dwelling unit plus \$3.00 for each additional dwelling unit plus \$2.00 for each fixture to be installed in each dwelling unit.
 - (3) For any other building or structure not specifically mentioned above \$5.00 for one stack and \$2.00 for each additional stack or fixture to be installed therein.
 - (4) Where the work to be performed is in addition to an existing plumbing installation the fee shall be \$5.00 plus \$2.00 for each additional stack or fixture to be installed.
 - (5) (a) For the inspection of any sewer lateral from the property line to any building or structure the fee shall be \$5.00
(b) In the event of conversion from septic service to sanitary sewer system the fee shall be as set out in 5(a) above plus \$5.00 for the connection to the existing plumbing drains.
 - (6) For any request for an inspection of any existing plumbing, drainage or water system which is not a routine inspection the fee shall be \$15.00 per hour or any part thereof.
 - (7) For extra inspections made necessary because of faulty or defective work or work not completed when inspection is called for, \$5.00 for each re-inspection in excess of one.
