

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW NO. 753(1982)

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and
Clerk to execute the necessary documents
to purchase land for a portion of a road
allowance.

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to purchase certain lands
from Gordon Munro Dale for use as a portion of a public road allowance.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the Town of Pelham purchase that part of Lot 32 as
shown on a compiled plan registered in the Registry Office for the Registry
Division of the County of Welland as Plan No. 25 for the Village of
Fonthill, now known as Plan 717, ~~now known~~ as Part 2 and which is on a
Reference Plan 59R-3651 for the Registry Division of Niagara South, at a
cost of two hundred dollars from Gordon Munro Dale.

(2) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby
authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation to execute the
necessary documents to complete the sale of the property and the Clerk is
hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
