THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #766 (1982)

Being a by-law to repeal By-law #611 (1980).

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham passed By-law #611 (1980), being a free standing by-law to rezone a Part of Block "C" according to Plan No. 16 for the Township of Pelham, now known as Plan 703 to "Residential Village (RV1) Zone", which by-law was subsequently approved by the Ontario Municipal Board;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham, by By-law #450 (1978), as amended, has designated the area as "Residential Village (RV1) Zone";

AND WHEREAS the approval of By-law #450 (1978), as amended, will render the provisions of By-law #611 (1980) redundant;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT By-law #611 (1980) be and is hereby repealed.
- (2) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of its passing, subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
