THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #784 (1982)

Being a by-law to change the name of a street in the Crescent Subdivision in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 210 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities for changing the names of highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable and necessary to change the name of a street in the registered plan of subdivision known as "The Crescent";

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the name of the road allowance as shown on Registered Plan 59M-94 in the Town of Pelham, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, in the former Village of Fonthill be and is hereby changed from "Crescent Gate" to "Pickwick Place":
- (2) THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect upon the registration of the by-law in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Niagara South.
