BY-LAW #797 (1982)

Being a by-law to establish a 60 k.p.h. speed
limit on Metler Road.

WHEREAS Subsection 2 of Section 109 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 198 provides that the Council of a municipality and the trustees of a police village may by by-law prescribe a higher or lower rate of speed for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction than is prescribed in Subsection 1 of Section 109;

AND WHEREAS the statutory speed limit on the portion of Metler Road between Maple Street and Balfour Street is 80 k.p.h. under the Highway Traffic Act, and the Regional Municipality of Niagara Act;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and advisable to lower the speed limit for motor vehicles on the portion of Metler Road 400 metres west of Balfour Street to Balfour Street in the municipality of the Town of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT when any highway or portion of highway, set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto, is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be the rate of speed prescribed in the schedule.
- (2) THAT the penalties provided in Subsection 13 of Section 109 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of Niagara and signs are erected.
