

## T O W N    O F    P E L H A M

BY-LAW NUMBER 82 (1971)

Being a By-law to regulate and fix the salaries and other remunerations to be allowed the Town officers for the year 1971 and to authorize the payment of the same.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS

AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the salaries and other remunerations to be allowed and paid to the persons filling the respective offices of the Town of Pelham named below for the year 1971 shall be as follows:

Committee of Adjustment - per annum - Chairman	\$300	<i>1000000</i> <i>#130 - 172,</i>
Secretary	\$300	
Others	\$250	

Selectors of Jurors - per day - \$8.00

Inspector of Ditches - \$2.75 per hr.

Fenceviewers - per day - \$10.00

Livestock Evaluators - \$8.00 per visit

Caretaker of Effingham Lights - \$50.00 per annum


Caretaker of North Pelham Lights - \$50.00 per annum

2. THAT the Mayor shall issue a cheque of the Treasurer to any of the officers above, designated for the salary and remuneration due him or them thereunder, whenever he shall be instructed to do so by resolution of Council.

3. THAT By-law #11 of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham be and the same is hereby rescinded.
