BY-LAW NO. 848 (1983)

Being a by-law to dedicate certain lands as a public park in Part of Lot 10, Concession 13.

WHEREAS Mr. Harold Silvester Bradshaw, deceased, late of the Town of Pelham has bequethed his lands and premises, being the north half of Lot 10, Concession 13, Town of Pelham to the Corporation of the Town of Pelham, subject to certain conditions;

 $\,$ AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to accept these lands and dedicate them as public park;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the area as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, be and is hereby dedicated as public park.
- (2) THAT the park shall be known as the "Harold S. Bradshaw Memorial Park".
- (3) THAT the monies comprising the residue of the estate shall be used for the establishment and maintenance of the said property.
- (4) THAT no topsoil shall ever be removed from the said property.
- (5) THAT the general management, regulation and control of the park property shall be exercised by the Town of Pelham Parks, Recreation and Community Centres Committee, who shall make such recommendations to Council, as it deems necessary, for the development and maintenance of the park area.
