BY-LAW NO. 850 (1983)

Being a by-law to regulate traffic in the Town of  
Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and desirable to enact certain regulations to control the parking of vehicles in the Town of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1)           SECTION I - DEFINITIONS: -

(a)    "Boulevard" shall mean, that part of the street lying between a curb, and the adjacent sidewalk or street limit and shall also mean and include any portion of a street set apart for a boulevard whether or not it is delimited by a curb.

(b)    "Curb" as applicable to a street whereon a stone, asphalt or concrete curb exists, shall mean such curb and where no such curb exists, shall mean the outer edge of that part of the highway used by vehicular traffic.

(c)    "Park" means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily, for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading and unloading.

(d)    "Street" or "Highway" shall mean a "Highway" as defined in the Highway Traffic Act.

(2)           SECTION II - OBEDIENCE TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS: -

1.   Enforcement

The Niagara Regional Police Department and/or the By-law Enforcement Officer of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham shall have the duty of enforcing the provisions of this by-law.

2.   Obedience to Traffic Signs

Any person in charge of a vehicle and every person on any street shall promptly obey all signals, given by a police officer, or by-law enforcement officer appointed to carry out the provisions of this by-law, for the purpose of directing or regulating traffic or hereinafter provided, and shall comply with the requirements of every sign, symbol or mark legally erected or placed for the purpose of regulating or directing traffic.

(3) SECTION III - AUTHORITY TO ERECT SIGNS: -

The Town Works Superintendent, subject to the jurisdiction of the Council, is hereby authorized to erect, place, install, mark or otherwise indicate and maintain on any street, such signs as may be necessary or expedient to ensure the due observance and enforcement of the provisions of this by-law.

(4) SECTION IV - ERECTION OF SIGNS: -

(a) No person shall erect, place, install, mark, maintain, remove or alter the location of any sign, except under the written authority of the Town Works Superintendent, or in any way interfere with, damage or destroy any signs.


(b) An officer of the Region of Niagara Police Force or the By-law Enforcement Officer of the Town of Pelham may erect or cause a temporary sign to be erected for the purposes of controlling and regulating traffic during emergencies, processions, parades and similar occurrences.

(5) SECTION V - PENALTIES: -

Any person violating any of the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalty of not more than FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) for the first offence and not more than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for every subsequent offence, exclusive of costs, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Ontario Summary Convictions Act.
