THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW NO. 861 (1983)

Being a by-law to repeal By-law #714 (1981), a by-law to establish a reserve fund to supplement a long term disability fund for municipal employees.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has obtained improved long term disability benefits for the employees set out in By-law #714 (1981), which provides equal coverage with the balance of the full time employees of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham, making supplementary coverage unnecessary;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT By-law #714 (1981) be and is hereby repealed.
- (2) THAT the monies deposited in the Reserve Fund for Long Term Disability Benefits be transferred to the Sick Leave Credit Reserve Fund.
