BY-LAW NUMBER 91 (1971)

Being a by-law to amend by-law #29 being a by-law to establish and provide an annual allowance to be paid to members of Council.

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Pelham deems it desireable to amend by-law #29.

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PEL-HAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT item #1 of By-law #29 be amended to read as follows:

"THAT the Mayor of Council be paid the sum of (\$3,500) three thousand, five hundred dollars, per annum and one-third of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties."

2. THAT item #2 of By-law #29 be amended to read as follows:

"THAT the Aldermen of Council be paid an annual allowance of (\$2,500) two thousand, five hundred dollars and one-third of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of his duties.

3. THAT these amendments to By-law #29 shall henceforth be in force and effect.
