Being a by-law to amend By-law #791 (1982),
being a by-law to establish and regulate a
market in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham
deems it necessary and desirable to amend By-law #791 (1982);


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Section (2) (1) be amended by the addition of the
following after "Niagara" in the fourth line - "and for the sale of fish
imported from beyond the boundaries of the Regional Municipality of Niagara."
- (2) THAT Section (4) be deleted in its entirety and the following
substituted in its place - "The market shall be open for the purpose of a
market, every Friday, from the hour of four in the afternoon (4:00 p.m.) to
dusk from June 15th. to October 31st."
- (3) THAT Section (8) (3) be amended by deleting the words "six" in
line two and substituting the words "five-thirty" in its place; by deleting
the time "6:00 p.m." in line two and substituting the time "5:30 p.m." in its
place and by adding the word "vacant" after the word "other" in line six.
