THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #918 (1984)

Being a by-law to authorize certain payments to certain landowners formerly within the geographic limits of the Central Pelham Urban Sewage Works Area.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham did pass, on the 19th. day of December, 1983, By-law #887 (1983), being a by-law to reduce The Central Pelham Urban Sewage Works Area;

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Municipal Board did, on February 17th., 1984, issue a Board Order approving By-law #887 (1983);

AND WHEREAS, on March 19th., 1984, Council approved a Finance Committee recommendation to reimburse all property owners now excluded from the Central Pelham Urban Sewage Works Area who had paid the levy assessed against all property owners within the Central Pelham Urban Sewage Works Area;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the landowners listed on Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part of this by-law shall be entitled to receive the monies adjusted to present value attributable to the taxation years and the lands all as listed on Schedule "A", pursuant to levies made upon them under the provisions of By-law #50 (1970) of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham, except where there are outstanding accounts owing to the Town in which case the monies shall be applied as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- (2) THAT the staff of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham are hereby directed to notify those landowners listed in Schedule "A" attached hereto and to make arrangements with them for payment to them of the monies mentioned in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- (3) THAT the Treasurer of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham shall retain any funds mentioned in Schedule "A" to this By-law as being attributable to any landowner who cannot be located by the staff of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and in the event that upon the expiry of two years any such landowner cannot be located by Town Staff, the Treasurer shall report to the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and the Council shall then determine the disposition of such funds.
