THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW # 933(1984)

Being a by-law to restrict the keeping of pigeons.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) REGULATED AREA:

The regulations as set out hereinafter shall apply to properties within the Town of Pelham designated in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

(2) KEEPING OF PIGEONS:

No Person shall keep, harbour or raise pigeons for any reason whatsoever within the regulated area as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto.

(3) EXISTING LOFTS:

All existing pigeon lofts within the Regulated Area shall be subject to the regulations of By-law #924 (1984) for the Town of Pelham.

(4) ENFORCEMENT:

 $\label{eq:An Enforcement Officer may enter upon any property within the Town for the purposes of enforcing this by-law.}$

(5) PENALTY

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law is liable to a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars exclusive of costs.
