

THE CORPORATION OF THE

BY-LAW #958 (1984)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #57 (1970), being
a by-law to regulate the discharge of firearms
within the limits of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section
210, Paragraph 29 empowers the Council of local municipalities to pass
by-laws for prohibiting or regulating the discharge of guns or other
firearms, air guns or any class thereof;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of
Pelham deems it necessary and advisable to amend By-law #57 (1970) of the
Town;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


(1) THAT Section 2 of By-law #57 (1970), as amended, be deleted in
its entirety and that the following be substituted in its place: -----

"(2) The discharge of any firearm, regardless
of calibre, which incorporates a rifled barrel
in its construction is hereby prohibited in the
Town of Pelham.

And further that the use of any projectile
or slug or shot larger than #2 gauge is hereby
prohibited in the Town of Pelham, except during
the period established by the Ministry of Natural
Resources for the hunting of deer, at which time
regulations established by the Ministry of Natural
Resources shall prevail."
