BY-LAW NUMBER 96 (1971)

Being a by-law to establish a 30 m.p.h.
speed limit on Hurricane Road.

WHEREAS Hurricane Road was formerly located
in the Township of Thorold and under section 59 of the
Highways Traffic Act, the speed limit was 50 m.p.h. and,

WHEREAS under Bill 235, an act to amend the
Regional Municipality of Niagara Act, 1968-69, by-laws
enacted by Council of a municipality under Section 59
of the Highway Traffic Act that applied on the 31st. day
of December, 1969, shall continue to apply until by-law
passed by the Regional Council or the local area munici-
pal Council under section 59 applies thereto and,

WHEREAS Section 59 (1.b) of the Highway Traffic
Act provides a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a highway with-
in a city, town, village, police village or built up
area.

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-


1. THAT the speed limit on the following roads
within the Town of Pelham shall be 30 m.p.h.:


<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Hurricane Rd.	N. Pelham St.	Highway #20
Welland Rd.	Effingham St.	Haist Rd. South

2. The provisions of this by-law shall be sub-
ject to the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O.
1960, Chapter 172 and the amendments thereto.


3. The provisions of this by-law shall not become

signs referred to herein have been erected and are
on display.
